

YESHUA PREACHED GOD

Yeshua points all who hear him to the God of Israel

Many Christians, even Unitarians, seem to make the mistake of worshiping the Messiah, the one anointed by Adonai, as if he was Adonai Himself.

This seems an almost universal failing of Christendom; that is, it is just not the Trinitarians and Oneness Christians, but also many if not most Unitarians such as the Christadelphians, who also seem to fail into the same trap.

Pastor Aubrey Burt gives a brilliant summary¹ of the true reality and relationship between the Messiah and his Father, the Creator of the Universe (this is a slightly paraphrased version):

"I say, YHVH is the center and focus of Yeshua's Message!

Yeshua came to please his Father, not to be the focus of mankind, but to teach mankind how to honor YHVH, THE ONE TRUE GOD.

What the Scriptures say about YHVH bring glory to YHVH!

What the scriptures say of Yeshua is that he brings the focus BACK to the FATHER, and His Torah, not to himself.

The Almighty wants no other gods before Him, yet many don't live UP to God's commandments, because the Yeshua/Jesus they preach abolished them, which now gives them the supposed right to make who they want, as the god they want.

The Son of God wants us to put our focus on YHVH, not himself.

WHO MADE YESHUA A MEDIATOR? YHVH.

Mark 4:30 'Yeshua also said, "With what can we compare the Kingdom of God? What illustration should we use to describe it?'

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*Mark 10:15 "Yes! I tell you, whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God like a child will not enter it!"
RECEIVE WHO'S KINGDOM? G O D's !!!*

*Mark 10:23 "Yeshua looked around and said to his talmidim (disciples), "How hard it is going to be for people with wealth to enter the Kingdom of God!"
ENTER WHO'S KINGDOM? G O D's !!!*

*Mark 14:25 "Yes! I tell you, I will not drink this 'fruit of the vine' again until the day I drink new wine in the Kingdom of God."
WHO'S KINGDOM DOES YESHUA EXPECT TO DRINK NEW WINE IN? G O D's !!!*

*Luke 4:43 "But he said to them, "I must announce the Good News of the Kingdom of God to the other towns too -- this is why I was sent."
WHAT KINGDOM WAS YESHUA SENT TO ANNOUNCE? G O D's !!!*

*Luke 9:60 Yeshua said, "Let the dead bury their own dead; you, go and proclaim the Kingdom of God!"
WHO'S KINGDOM DID YESHUA SAY TO PROCLAIM? G O D's !!!*

*Luke 22:15 said to them, "I have really wanted so much to celebrate this Seder with you before I die! 16 For I tell you, it is certain that I will not celebrate it again until it is given its full meaning in the Kingdom of God."
WHEN DOES PASSOVER GET IT'S---> FULL MEANING,<---- ACCORDING TO YESHUA? IN THE KINGDOM OF G O D !!!*

*John 3:5 Yeshua answered, "Yes, indeed, I tell you that unless a person is born from water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God."
ENTER WHO'S KINGDOM? G O D's !!!*

*Acts 1:3 After his death he showed himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. During a period of forty days they saw him, and he spoke with them about the Kingdom of God.
WHO'S KINGDOM DID HE SPEAK ABOUT AFTER HIS DEATH? G O D's !!!*

YESHUA PREACHED GOD."

Yeshua pointed all the 'lost sheep of Israel' back to the Almighty, NOT to himself.

This was of course what had been prophesied in Deuteronomy 18. Indeed, if Yeshua had done any different, and had instead tried to introduce new instructions and new ways of finding peace with the Almighty, then he would have disqualified himself from the very role of a Messiah and Son of God.

That he was resurrected by the Almighty is a most conclusive demonstration that his Father had accepted his obedience and life's mission. Yeshua found great favour in God's eye.

Yeshua, in his allegiance and deference to Adonai, has given us the greatest of examples.

To give all, or even primary, glory and allegiance to Yeshua would not be to truly follow his teachings, and so it would make us a poor student and not win his great approval.

Do we not all wish to hear those great words, 'Well done, thy good and faithful servant'!

Whose servant are we to be? The Almighty's - our Creator; our King of Kings; the lover of our souls; the Father of our youth and the Father of our maturity, the great and awesome YHVH!
